CITY OF HAHIRA HIRES MAIN STREET DIRECTOR

HAHIRA, GA – After a lengthy search, the City of Hahira recently hired a new Main Street Director. Emily Perry Davenport will work with Hahira business owners, the Downtown Development Authority, and the Hahira City Council to enhance economic development opportunities in Downtown Hahira. She will coordinate special events, implement new ideas and resources, and meet with business owners to help bring profitable impact to business within the City of Hahira.

Mrs. Davenport is a graduate of Valdosta State University with a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Environmental Geography, and a Master of Public Administration from the same institution.
