and Phase II. Phase I is in the process of
being closed and thanks to reallocation of
funds from COVID we can move forward
with Phase II. We have reviewed the
documents and Council found a few things
that we need to address and we will work

with GEFA staff to get these items recorded. We are requesting approval of the loan documents pending certain line items. We would also like to include approval for the latest estimate included today. Does anyone have any questions? None noted. Councilman Luke made a motion to move forward with Phase II and authorization for bidding which was seconded by Councilman Barfield. Councilman Luke, Councilman Lindsey, Councilman Barfield and Mayor Pro Tem White all voted in favor of the motion.

B. WIIN GRANT DOCUMENTS-\$1,390,000-WELL #1 REDRILL-GEFA (CITY MANAGER)

Mayor Cain stated we did not receive the documents and we will wait for them to arrive. City Manager Sumner stated he contacted GEFA and the documents are still under review with them and then they will send them to us. We can then have attorney review along with Council and move forward for the December 1 deadline. Councilman Luke made a motion to postpone until the documents are received and reviewed which was seconded by Councilman Lindsey. Councilman Luke, Councilman Barfield, Councilman Lindsey and Mayor Pro Tem White all voted in favor of the motion.
